RAILROAD HISTORY

History master Don Watson was present and gave us a history lesson on track! Beginning in 1925, when Don was 3 years old and had his American Flyer set, he wondered why his track had only 3 ties per section? I don't believe he ever got an answer. Later, when older and walking along the local tracks, Don noticed the differences in track and ties. Rail height/size, tie plates or not, different rail jointers with different number of bolts- 4, 6 or 8, and tie spacing and size. In 1893 the Railroad Safety Act made track standards common for everyone. During the 1900's, track safety keep going with standard tie size and ties treated with creosote. In the 70's, Canada railroads started using a liquid treating material that turned the ties a greenish color. And currently, welded rail and concrete ties are becoming the norm in many places! Great stories! Thanks Don for the history and information! We look forward to another lesson soon!
