PRODUCT REVIEW

Bruce gave us a review on GE ES44ac loco's - do not buy - they have been seen with the reversing headlight function NOT working correctly! Actually, these were REAL loco's and yes, the headlights were NOT in their proper working configuration!

RAILROAD HISTORY

History "Prof" Norm gave the floor to Bruce Wolfe for our history lesson this month. "I feel the need for speed" as in hi-speed rail! Japan started with "bullet train", France has the TGV and even US has Acela-Amtrak in northeast corridor, which regularly runs at 150 mph! In 1970 Montreal Loco works (Canada Alco division) built the LRC- Light Rapid Comfortable loco and train system. It has an active tilting system on curves and loco has lower center of gravity. (Via rail bought loco's in 1980's) The LCR train set a Canada rail speed record at 129 MPH. That stood for 1.5 months when it was shattered by the Turbo Train. In 1976 a 9 car Turbo train hit 140 mph in Canada! In US, same Turbo train with a 3 car set hit 170.8 mph, setting a record that still stands! It was the fastest production train. But, what was the fastest train on rail ever in the US? How about a Budd build RDC with jet engines on top! Built by the NYC, in July 1966 it topped out at 183.8 mph! It was mentioned that at the NMRA National convention for this summer, one of the trips is on the Acela at 150+ mph! THANKS Bruce for the fast information! Looking forward to another lesson next month.

SHOW AND TELL

A subject we had not done before - something with interior detailing- structure, loco, rolling stock. Items shown were a FSM-freight house; passenger car Pullman std coach; DPM bldg; Walther pass car; pass cars from Fred Deylger; O scale Brakeman shanty; laser kit B&O tower; DPM bldg; lumber office bldg; Magnason Models structure; scratch built gas station; box car with LCL freight; observation car; gas-electric engine & coach; store building; diner; and yard office shack. Make out of old brief case or small suitcase. You fill it with foam from craft stores, and cut holes for stuff with an electric knife! Mark "top" of case with your RR logo, so you know how to open it. Source for cases - yard sales, Kmart (\$19). Get 3" green foam from craft stores. Works well and keeps your stuff straight and neat! Tip from another Div 6 member- can also use hacksaw blade for foam cutting - father was upholsterer! Great idea and presentation - THANKS Norm! WHO WE ARE

We are Division 6 of the North Central Region (NCR) of the National Model Railroad Association (NMRA). What that means is, the NMRA is the model railroad association for the country (and even world). The country is divided into REGIONS, which are one or more states. Our Region, the North Central Region (NCR), is all of Michigan and the northern part of Ohio and Indiana. Each Region is then divided into DIVISIONS, which are one or more counties. Division 6 is primarily Wayne County, but we have many members from western Oakland County and we aren't strict on membership and boundaries. Oakland and Macomb Counties are Division 8, the Ann Arbor area is Division 9 and a new Division has been formed in the Flint-Saginaw area. All total, there are about 8 Divisions in our Region.
