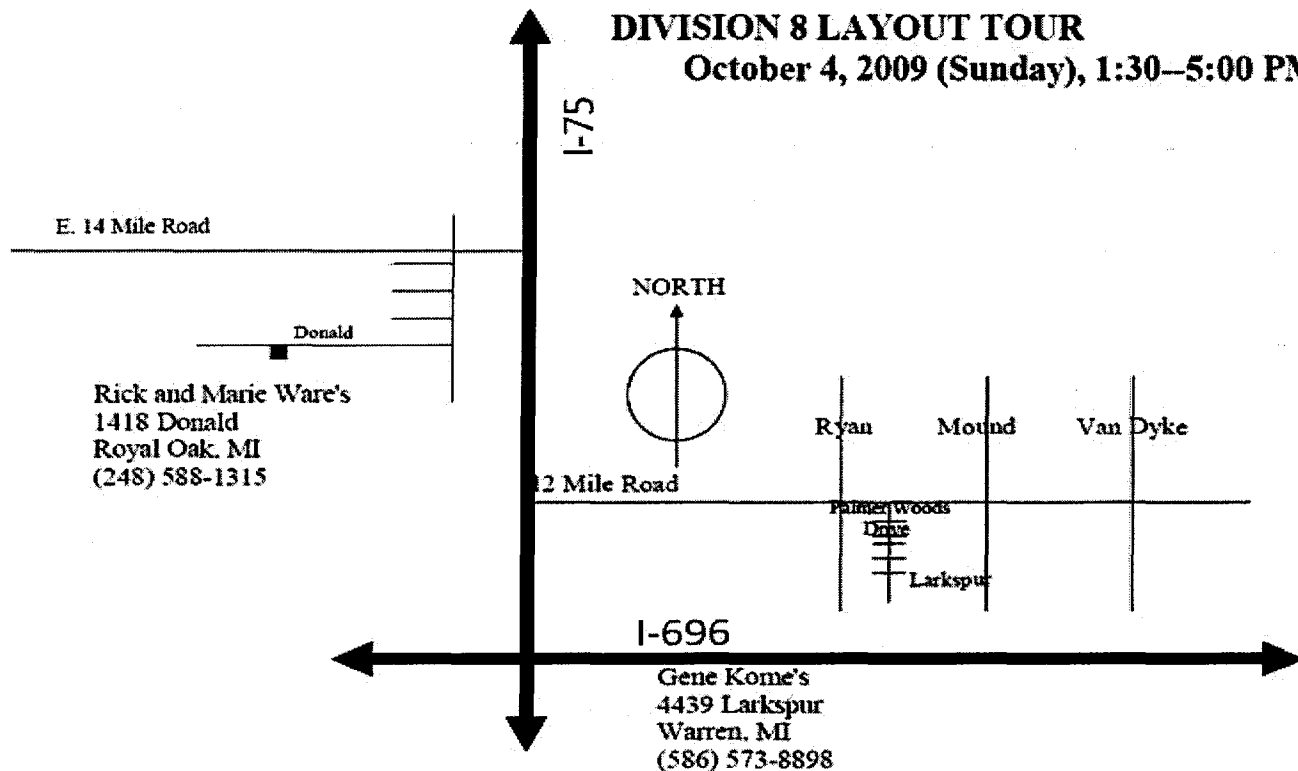

DIVISION 8 LAYOUT TOUR

October 4, 2009 (Sunday), 1:30-5:00 PM



Please note that Gene Kome lives in a gated community called Palmer Woods Estate. The gate should be open. PLEASE PARK ON WEST SIDE OF PALMER WOODS DRIVE. NOT ON LARKSPUR

Gene models the Santa Fe of the 1970s and 80s in western Illinois, a section popularly called "the Racetrack" because of its fast freights between Chicago and Kansas City. His HO Scale layout features farms, feed mills, a cement plant, small towns, a glass bottle plant, and a food distributor. Scenery is about 80% complete, and four track staging yards at each end produce traffic density for this heavily traveled route. The layout has about 130' of double-track mainline.

Indoor Layout: Rick models the Chesapeake & Ohio, Greenbrier Division, in HO Scale. The scenery features autumn foliage and is about 90% complete. The track plan is a point-to-loop system along three walls and based on the prototype branch-line and Cass Scenic RR in eastern West Virginia during the mid-1960s. It features the towns of Ronceverte, Marlinton and Cass with a number of scratch-built models of actual structures, such as, the passenger depot at Ronceverte, the leather tannery at Marlinton and the company store at Cass.

Outdoor Layout: The G Scale Loon Lake Railway & Navigation Company features live plants and real running water. This freelanced pike is loosely based on upper Michigan logging and mining. It has several hundred feet of single-track main folded in a loop plus passing and industrial sidings. A variety of structures and bridge grace the terrain, and the railroad operates with small steam locomotives and one center-cab diesel.
