**** TIP** Bill Deeter had another great quick tip for us this month... a quick and easy way to store small paint brushes, or pens/pencils, or anything with a small handle. Take an empty can, like a tuna can. Cut corrugated cardboard into strips the same height as the can and fill the can with these strips by rolling them together. With the cardboard strips on edge in the can, your brushes can be pushed into the cardboard, handle end first, which will hold it nicely! COOL!

**** Another Div 6 member asked** about the product that many use for filling in the brick mortar on buildings.... Roberts Brick Mortar is the product and it can usually only be purchased direct.

The model contest was well attended with over 80 entries and Jim/Larry helped judge the contest. The Train Show was also down in vendors, as space was a bit costly. One nice aspect was that Larry took the train out to the convention - what a way to relax and get the max train exposure for the event! He met a few others on the train, also headed to the convention, so the trip itself was fun too! One bright spot was a double header narrow gauge steam train at Knotts Berry Farms Park! Next years' convention will be held in Hartford!

Thinking of hosting a layout tour?, give Dick a call or email if you would like to have your layout on a tour!

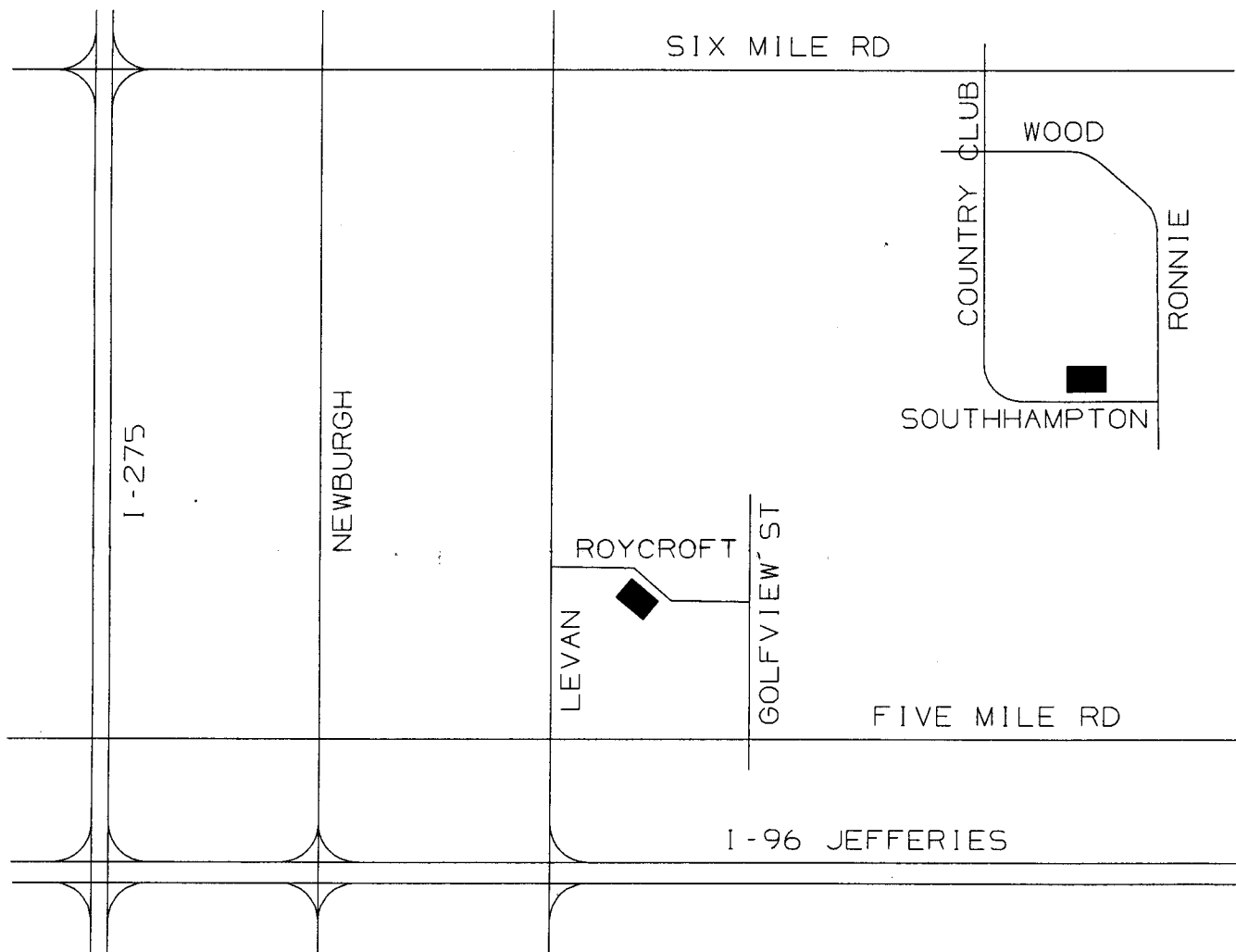
