RAILROAD HISTORY

Norm was present and thus had a history lesson this past month. C&O Hist magazine - DATE NAILS-3000 ties per mile used on RR's; demand for ties increased greatly after Civil War. Untreated ties lasted 7-10, treated lasted 30+ years. 1897 was first date nail in ties, for record keeping in tracking tie wear. Most were the same, but some nails had odd shaped heads that meant specific per RR. Most were steel, but copper, iron and aluminum were used too. 1969 was the last year used as computers keep track of ties and some ties are now composite or even concrete. Interesting stuff!! Looking forward to another lesson soon.

MAUMEE EXPRESS 2014

The 2014 NCR convention, the Maumee Express was held in Toledo on April 25-27. It was a shortened convention with no tours on Sunday and no prototype tours. 
MICHIGAN RAILROAD CLUB PROGRAMS June 04, 2014 - MRC Member John Curtright with "Rails Around Atlanta"
