

# CLINIC

WE ALWAYS NEED CLINICS for our meetings! If you are willing to do a clinic, please, e-mail/call Joe Bliss!! PLEASE volunteer to present a LIVE clinic, share your knowledge and talents! The clinic for this month was by Matt Letts on grain elevators !! (my bad as Editor that I too, forgot this fact!) Matt gave a good clinic, computer presentation with pictures and text explaining grain elevators, also known as "prairie skyscrapers"! These can be small or very large, the 2nd largest is in Kansas and is a 1/2 mile long! Grain elevators were started in the 1840's with the first built in Buffalo, NY. There are 2 main types - collection and terminal. The names are descriptive of their function... collection type is where all the farmers take their grain. The Terminal elevator is where the grain is distributed. Grain elevators are dangerous places, as that can explode with great force. As for the railroading end of the grain business, boxcars were used for hauling grain until the early 1960's, when covered hoppers came into existence. With the railroads hauling grain, it was possible to get grain anywhere in the world faster. THANKS Matt for a great clinic!
