## **MODELING INFO W/LARRY**

LARRY's TIPS for this month were-Larry showed dollar tree green clumbs (Styrofoam with grass glued on) that can be cut to make small hills and ground features. He also showed plastic lids to containers (butter, lunch meat, etc) to be used as palettes and for mixing paint. Larry finds many calcium chloride cars - gons with special built on racks. However, he has never a car with the containers or seen a container. He makes his containers for calcium chloride cars from diabetic needle caps. Larry was tweaking car couplers and needed some shims, however they were hard to paint once installed. So he made several sizes of shims for under couplers, painted the edges in advance and stores them in a parts box. Lastly Larry also showed misc shapes from misc items in the house to make roof vents and details. We look forward to more questions and/or tips next month!
