WE ALWAYS NEED CLINICS for our meetings! If you are willing to do a clinic, please, LET US KNOW! We STILL NEED someone to volunteer to be Clinic Chairman! PLEASE share your talents and knowledge! This month's clinic was on Aluminum Backdrop construction by MMR Ken Chick. Pioneered by others, this background method has several big advantages... it can be seamless, no corners and easy to use. Sheet aluminum in 24" or 36" widths is hung from a plastic J channel, to create the backdrop. The aluminum is already primed, so regular latex house paint can be used on it. 
