### MODELING INFO W/LARRY

Here are LARRY's TIPS for this month- what you can do with rope!! Cyclser twine- cut with scissors, cut into small lengths, Paint brown, mix with WS grass - great under-brush. Also use to line bottom of livestock cars- mixed 2/3 rope with 1/3 WS tall grass cut the same size. Spray adhesive is used to fasten "straw" onto floor of cars - use a cardboard "mask" to spray the floor with adhesive, sprinkle on straw, do over box-top or tray to catch loose straw to reuse. Can also use wet water and scenic cement. Thanks Larry for some great info! We look forward to more questions, tips next month!

# RAILROAD HISTORY

Norm was present to do a History lesson! He read from the book- "The Great Trains"... covers trains from many countries and he read about passenger trains that were considered "great". In the USA part- George Pullman made passenger travel great with his Pullman cars and their new standard for luxury travel. 1847 started regular passenger service in the east. Some early runs were publicity runs made to extreme timing to prove possible regular runs - NY to SanF run in 87 hours! NE corridor also set the tone for future passenger service at the turn of the century, NYNH&H set 3 trains from Boston to NY in a 5 hours trip each in 1903 with exquisite accommodations! Late 1800's PRR and B&O (w/RDG and CNJ) competed in fast east coast travel! Travelers to Florida went in style in 1888 with Pullman cars in the Florida special. This ran from Washington DC to Jacksonville FL. Soon after, a train from Wash DC to Atlanta was started and expanded from NY to New Orleans the Crescent Limited! Norm also talked about the famed NY to Chicago PRR and NYC trains and their rivalry! Lots of great history and information! Thanks Norm, looking forward to another lesson soon.

# NCX - NCR-DIV 6 2010 CONV

The North Central Express dates are October 21-24, 2010!

The good news for this month is that the proto-type tours are coming together nicely. We've heard back from the Sunoco distribution depot by the airport and we're 99% all set there. We have to sign their waiver and provide some insurance info and then schedule the tours. We'll have 2 tours with about 35 people on each tour allowed. GREAT! We've also secured tours at the warehouse that ships GM engines by rail in Romulus and we're set for 2 tours there. We're still in contact with the NS dispatching Center in Dearborn and we still have 1 or 2 more places to

check on and the Henry Ford. If we get anything there, it will be at an extra cost.

The layout tour maps have been started - THANKS Dan Kempf! We need to have these done by the beginning of October for the event book printing. Please see Dan at the next Div 6 meeting to make sure YOUR page is correct!!

Our biggest deadline is for the middle of August, when we need to have the prototype tours all set and OPS session all set. Then at the end of August, we'll start mailing those schedules out to the pre-registered people so they can sign-up for the activities they want.

Registrations are still coming in, we're up to approx. 65! That includes some free registrations to out-of-state people that will be clinic presenters. Besides Guy Quick, these are the only people getting a free pass, because they are coming a distance, are not NCR members and are doing us a favor by sharing their knowledge.

We've started to crank-up our media machine. We're listed in the next 3 Scale Rails issues and word has been sent to all of the major magazines. Local promotion of the convention through all of the local news outlets and hobby shops will start in September and October!

Please get with Walt at the next 2 Div 6 meetings to start confirming your NCX work schedule. Like the Fall Show, without YOU, the Div 6 membership, this great convention could not happen. All of the jobs are easy, 10 minutes of training and you're good to go!

Lastly, if you know a local business owner that can use some cheap promotion, talk to them about making a flyer for our goodie bag - we need 225 or so, one for each bag! This is a very inexpensive way to advertise a local business! Get ready- NCX is ONLY 2.5 months away!
