BILL'S TOOL TIME

Div 6 member Bill Deeter presents different tools and ideas. This month Bill showed and spoke of-Micro Mart offering free shipping - take advantage! Wire striper from MM, found one very similar at Harbor Freight for less than half cost and well made.

Plastic lid from Dannon yogurt 32oz fits over cottage cheese lid 24oz, near perfect fit - use to keep detail/pinstriping (1/4" wide or smaller) tape clean and dry! Old drafting pencil holder can hold dental tool end for a nice handle for scribing. Lastly-The rectangular steel cabinet scraper which works like a very fine cutting plane is a familiar tool to wood workers. The scraper is "sharpened" on one edge only and is drawn across the surface. This tool can be adapted to remove mold marks from plastic parts. The scraper is best cut from a slightly hard piece of approx. 14 Gage steel. (old saw blade or metal spatula) The scraper is sharpened by clamping it in a vise and rounding over an edge by drawing a burnisher along. The object is to create a razor sharp edge (bur) on either side. The result is like the bur left when sheet steel is sheared.

Don't test the edge with your finger. If you did it right, you will slice the finger open. Looking forward to another tool tip next month.

MODELING INFO W/LARRY

LARRY'S TIPS for this month were-Larry showed all of his rolling stock that he had completed in the last month including a log flat car. Which side of the car is right/left? Car ends are A and B -B end has the brake wheel/lever. Well, if you stand at the B end look to the A end, left is left, etc... ALSO- pin vises- takes a while to drill holes. New ideastart hole with pin vise, then put pin vice in cordless drill! Larry uses straight pins, cut in half, inserted into figures so they are movable and they "spike" into the Styrofoam scenery! Larry also needs a Kadee #78 coupler - got one? We look forward to more questions and/or tips next month!

Always wanted to convert to high guality drivers and wheels -Bachman has a wheel set that will work, except for the one geared axle. Joe told that he used heat shrink tubing to help insulate a new axle into the new wheels (due to different gear - (worm -vs- std gear). Worked great!
