RAILROAD HISTORY

Norm was present at the last meeting and had a history lesson for us. With it being so hot out lately, Norm gave us the History of dry ice! In 1835 dry ice invented by French chemist and in 1897 the English were using dry ice for soda water. 1925 was the first real commercial use of dry ice/Co2 - fire extinguisher! Dry ice has twice the cooler power as regular ice. It was sold to RR's for refers. In 1932 there were 12 cars made for dry ice cooling. Dry ice then used widely in shipping ice cream! 120 million pounds made/used in 1930's. Mechanical refrigeration on rail cars and trucks put dry ice out of the main stream market. Thanks Norm for "cooling" us off! Looking forward to another lesson.

Our next modeling for bragging rights contest will be in September! (yes, it must be 12"x12" not rectangular!). We will use 12x12 for N and HO scale. For S and O scale, you are allowed 18"x18" square. G scale is allowed a 24"x24" square. Remember, each display must include track! Have fun and we look forward to seeing your modeling!

MODELING INFO W/LARRY

LARRY's TIPS for this month were-Larry showed a weighted clamp to hold Kadee boxes on car chassis while the glue dries. Larry also showed us some wood structures he was making and used a 30-30-30 water-ink-show polish mixture for staining the wood. Looked great! Another neat trick Larry had is that he puts wax paper over flat balsa wood that he uses as a small work surface. He uses these to stain wood or build trusses. The wax paper keeps wood clean while doing staining/gluing and the parts do not stick to wax paper! We look forward to more questions and/or tips next month!

CLINIC

WE ALWAYS NEED CLINICS for our meetings! If you are willing to do a clinic, please, e-mail/call Joe. The clinic for this past meeting was a presentation by Div 6 member Bruce Wolf on clinic on prototype diesel locomotives "kit-bashing or repowering". We do these with our models and Bruce showed us how the real railroads switch out and convert locomotives to new "green" power. Bruce works for MTU Corp which are diesel engine builders. He showed a video of how a diesel engine works - cool!! The presentation showed series 4000 engine that meets tier 3 and Calif emission standards! A 12 cyl engine makes 2400 HP and the 16 cyl is good for 3200 HP. Low emissions, low torque, great fuel economy, less expensive and better performance! These are used to repower GP38's and SD40's. The Gulf and Ohio railways has purchased several of these and the Knoxville loco works did the rebuilding. Engine/trans plus gear reduction unit bolts into existing loco and mates up to existing traction alternator !! Cost varies, but is about \$750,000.

NEXT MEETING- Div 6 member Barry Hensel will have a mini-clinic on MoW vans he just completed.
