PRODUCT REVIEW

Member Bill Neale talked about using Digitrak DCC and radio throttles. Sometimes, trains drop from system - theory is that in plugging throttles in/out will create noise that makes radio receiver "disconnect" from system. For approx. \$50 you can buy a LNRP Module. This plugs into loconet system between the main board and the radio receiver, isolating the receiver from system channels. This seems to cut out the problem noise. Also it is suggested that you use a 14-16 volt wall transformer for system, instead of the 12v one supplied by Digitrak for better overall system performance. If you have an item to review, see Glenn before the meeting starts.
