The 2017 NCR convention will be hosted by Div 4 - the Grand Rails Division, in Grand Rapids. More info in the December HotBox.


Apologies in advance, as I will not be in attendance at the December Div 6 meeting. I will need someone to take some notes for me so I can do the next newsletter.




