
MODELING INFO W/LARRY

CLINIC

WE ALWAYS NEED CLINICS for our meetings! If you are willing to do a clinic, please, LET US KNOW! We NEED someone to volunteer to be Clinic Chairman! PLEASE volunteer to present a LIVE clinic, share your talents and knowledge! This month's clinic was on the M1 Rail Project, the Q Line in Detroit! This was delayed from last month due to the weather. Rep Nicole Brown attending the meeting and gave the presentation. It's been over 50 years since Detroit has had street running trains! A few members gave some stories/memories of the original street car lines interesting! There is a stop within walking distance to the Detroit Amtrak station! This gives you quite a bit of access to everywhere! Line is currently 3.3 miles long. Most of the project was paid for by private donations! Trains will run all week long, various hours. There are 12 stops on the line and \$1.50 is the base fare, with discounts for seniors, military and others. Interaction with the People Mover is great, so travel all over downtown is possible. Cars run on both, catenary lines and battery power! All cars will be out on the system doing testing, in late February. Actual ridership should start near Memorial Day weekend. NCR UPDATE


