Div 6 member Bill Deeter was at the last meeting, but had nothing new to report on. We are looking forward to another tool tip soon.







The layout depicts the PRR Panhandle Division as it was in September 1939, from mile post 25 to milepost 50 as the Pennsy went west from Pittsburgh toward Columbus, through some rugged terrain. Bill's layout features highly detailed prototype scenes modeled from photographs. The railroad and equipment is designed to focus on operations using 100% DCC sound equipped steam locomotives for motive power

My layout is based on the Great Northern Railway between Skykomish and Wenatchee over Stevens Pass in Washington in October 1955. The layout is in a basement of approximately 1400 square feet. The track is complete and scenery about 99%. The mainline is 480 feet staging to staging. Operation of the layout is Time Table, Train Order with a Dispatcher and an Agent/Operator.


