He was considered the quensential engineer, always on time with people setting their watches by his runs. He is remembered most for is last run, when he died to help save his passenger train from a collision, staying on board the loco to slow it down. His actions did save many lives as the train slowed from near 80 mph to under 35 mph when the impact occurred. Some other  $\,$ interesting facts were told of this famous railroader! 




We have found evidence of the "Steam-bigot" running a diesel powered train at a recent OPS session!!! OUCH!!!!
