NEWSLETTER ISSUES

Division 6 members I would like to first start out by apologizing for the delivery issues surrounding the monthly newsletters. I have been experiencing a two pronged issue which I will highlight for you along with the remediation steps that have taken place or will take place.

Issue 1 - Email delivery issues. Even though I have been sending out the notices regarding the publishing of the newsletter on the division website many of you have not been receiving them or they have been much delayed. I have been in discussions with my internet service provider (Provide.net) which is a DSL connection. They have done much research and had been unable to see anything on their end in terms of server delays or emails being blocked. Last week working together we were able to determine that the issue was with the line provider AT&T, after 3 modem replacements and a completely new wire from the pole to my house I think we have finally fixed the data transfer errors that were occurring of which neither myself or Provide.net were able to see. Issue 2 - USPS delivery issues for those that get a hard copy mailed. Every month due to the fact that I have over 40 newsletters and a very small mailbox on my porch the newsletters have been placed in a mailbox at the entrance of my neighborhood. I have been in contact with the Livonia Post Office to alert them of the delivery issues. After several weeks of communication they have stated that they have determined the issue and it should no longer occur going forward. Because the actual post office is not too far from my house to be on the safe side I will take the extra step going forward to drop them off there for delivery instead of trusting the mailbox near my house. Thank you for your patience and understanding in this matter.





