#### RAILROAD HISTORY

John Bopp presented a story on Tank Cars! Brooklyn Eagle newspaper May 1902 - Sheraton, PA gas explosion- over 100 dead and 300 injured; Railroad wreck of tank cars with 36" main under wreckage - worried pipe will rupture and cause bigger explosion. Tank cars being switched in the yard when one exploded. Other cars also caught fire! Also a station caught fire. All told, 3 different explosions took place with these railroad cars. With the 3rd one, the hillsides caught fire, where townsfolk were watching the original fires... this is where many were lost. This event helped get tank car standards revised and better! Thanks John, we're looking forward to another lesson soon.


