








DIVISION 6 – NCR – NMRA *LAYOUT TOURS*SUNDAY, MARCH 24, 2013 1pm-4pm

A 20' x 10' two level walk-in layout, scenery is 95% completed. A small-town Bridge Railroad servicing a large industrial district and a coal mine. It has 3 staging yards and interchanges with 2 class A railroads.

The Manistee & North Eastern is located in the rural area of Michigan's northern Lower Peninsula during the 1920's. It serves the northern hardwood forests at the end of the logging era with small towns and businesses associated with the logging industry. The layout is a point to point, all steam operation and features a variety of scratch built and kit bashed and kit built buildings. Motive power is from the NYC, MC, PM, C&O and GTW. 75% of the track and 25% of the scenery is complete.
