Some of Joe's advice was to test decoders first - use tester - available or can build one; Test motor current draw to make sure you are using proper decoder. Sometimes installing 2 decoders work best for the many functions that you may want - mars lights, etc... one sound/one silent. Enclose speaker in a box to make sound better/louder - make out of styrene. Joe showed many installs that he did, talked about some common problems of different manufactures. MODELING INFO W/LARRY

Here are **LARRY's TIPS** for this month- Larry showed a "MoW tool"... which was a sanding block that was adjustable to use belt sanding belts for sanding benchwork/cork, and large areas. Pin vises are available in 2 sizes, but the largest may not be big enough. Make your own LARGE pin vise by using a file handle, threaded rod and Jacob chuck. Thanks Larry for some great info! *OTHER TIPS-*

Neil Allen has source for SINTRA, which is a plastic used in sign making, that John Wissenger had mentioned in a recent clinic. A 4x8x1/8" thick sheet is \$37-47 depending on color, 1/4" thick is \$73-100. Scrap pieces are available from \$1.50-4 per sq foot. Eight colors are available.
