MODELING INFO W/LARRY

LARRY'S TIPS for this month weremany !! Larry showed a home-made and a purchased sanding block for making sure your cork roadbed was nice and smooth before laying track. He then showed how crepe from shoe cleans sandpaper and is available at wood working stores. Larry mentioned that Hobby Lobby has rare earth magnets that have many uses. He also showed 3 different clamps and their uses. Larry also recommended using a pin vise to mount bolster tubes on rolling stock. Lastly, Larry mentioned 2x and 3x cable cutters work very well for cutting seizer rope.

TIP from member Paul Omilian, who says that using heat shrink tubing over couplers to lash loco's together when your track is a bit uneven.
