DIVISION OF CHOICE



WE ALWAYS NEED CLINICS for our meetings! If you are willing to do a clinic, please, e-mail/call Joe Bliss! PLEASE volunteer to present a LIVE clinic, share your talents and knowledge! This month's clinic was by Div 6 member Rich Kubic on lightning, DCC and servo motors.

Rich had an extensive hand-out, containing lots of information on his subject matter. Lightening! Dangerous! Deadly! To both life & limb and your model RR equipment! A lightning strike can fry your electronics! A surge protector is always recommended to protect your system! Rich also talked about "noisy" electricity. This is electricity that fluxuates in power ratings. This can be "cleaned-up" with power conditioners.

Last, Rich talked about servo motors... usually used in the RC hobby, but we can use them for movement control of many things. Many feel this is a better way to control turnouts. Rich had a nice demo unit to show how they work! Thanks for the very interesting information Richard!


