The clinic for this month was "Importing Brass Imports", by Mr. George Kohs George just doesn't import brass models, but has been involved in producing models! Has been at this for 30+ years. Japan was first producer, then Korea and now it's soon becoming questionable where future loco will be made. Current models are produced from cad drawings, including 3D solid modeling models. The process is more difficult, due to the technology and skill level for detailing and assembling the locos. Some projects have included several hundred drawings of prototypes to make a good model. It takes 4-5 years to gather the information to just start a project locomotive. Produces locos and rolling stock in O scale. Customer base is in 27 countries and of many/all types of people.
