MODELING INFO W/LARRY

LARRY's TIPS for this month were-Organize! Use binders to keep sketches and info in order and neat. Binder titles Larry uses master layout; model supplies; paint formulas; train conceptsideas. Mark added an idea to use sheet protectors for decal storage.

Div 6 member Bill Rubarth had a tip on Testors dullcote in the brush-on type. It's very good for using on RR trucks!!

Bill also mentioned a tip originated with Joe Bliss - Use silicon tubing (Du-Bro brand #221) on the tender connector pin to keep drawbar on the engine when engine/tender are picked up and moved off track.

Bill also mentioned using plastic wrap (like celephane) to wrap loco's/cars for transport in boxes to keep them from getting finger-printed.
