#### RAILROAD HISTORY

Norm had a history lesson at the last meeting. He presented an article by Bill Miller on the Detroit, Bay City and Western RR. This railroad was started by three brothers (Handy Bros.) after selling two others. However, the route from Bay City to Detroit already had 4 other railroads in the area. Seems this project was never intended to be built, but was just for money gain! But it did get built all the way from Bay City to Port Huron. They did extend southerly to Mt. Clemens and Marine City. WWI did not allow them to extend to Detroit. In 1923 one of the Bros died and the RR went into steep decline. Feb 1925 was the last train run. Parts of the railroad exist as parts of other railroads, having been absorbed once it went bankrupt. Looking forward to another lesson soon.
