
DIV 6 MI-TRACK LAYOUT

It is the most beloved car on the tracks, well, maybe except for the locomotive. There are many names for the caboose - hack, cabin car, crummy, way car and a few others, depending on the railroad. The origins of the caboose are lost to history but it seems likely that the first cabooses appeared in the 1840s. They were probably makeshift boxcar conversions, hastily assembled to provide an office for the conductor and a place to keep necessary tools at the ready. 


